

## Communal Boarding

*This new style of boarding kennel is a hit on the West Coast – pet owners will travel hours to leave their dog at one of the few locations offering this unique arrangement!*

A communal kennel houses groups of 3-6 dogs together in the same large run. The group members are placed together based on size and personality, assuring that everyone is happy.

The dogs explore, play and rest together through-out the day – whether in their run or the large play-yard.

During meals and night-time each dog settles in their individual crate, allowing slow eaters to relax and restless sleeper to not wake others.

The atmosphere in a communal kennel is different from the average boarding facility:

- Dogs are never left alone – a canine buddy is always there.
- Dogs are content, always able to play with a friend or take a nap whenever they choose.
- Dogs get plenty of fresh air and lots of exercise.
- As a result, there is little to no barking, giving the facility a peaceful aura.

## Training

The following skills can be taught to any dog that is boarding or in day care:

- Basic Manners (CGC prep.)
- Novice Obedience (CD prep.)
- Rally Novice (RN prep.)
- Basic Agility Safety
- Fun Tricks
- How to **Read\***
- Helpful Tasks\*\*

*Basic Manners* are a prerequisite for all other classes, but need not have been taught at **WTAB**.

\*\*Turn on lights, open doors, retrieve items... These are not 'tricks' for working dogs, however any dog can learn them to help around the house.

## Grooming

Offering breed appropriate grooming services for all dogs (mixed breeds are groomed as the breed they most resemble)

Grooming services include (\*as needed):

1. Hair Clipping\*
2. Brushing
3. Bathing and Drying
4. Nails and Ears\*

## Rates

### **Communal Boarding**

\$20\*/night per dog

### **Day Care**

\$10/day per dog

### **Training**

\$10/day per dog (plus boarding/day care)

### **Grooming**

\$30+ Varies depending on breed and preferred style.

- for a ltd. time – regular fee is \$25

*If anything unusual (such as a skin rash or lump) is noticed during your dog's visit, you will be informed.*

*Some restrictions apply as to breed and temperament.*

*Advice is always given freely.*

## Boarding / Day Care

When your dog attends 'camp' at **WTAB**, they will have full days ahead of them – here is a typical schedule:

- Each dog is evaluated and placed in a group based on size and personality.
- After drop-off, pups greet and gossip\* while the groups start a rotating schedule of 20 minute sessions in the large play-yard.
- At noon, all dogs come back inside for a siesta in their crates and those that receive a mid-day meal will have lunch.
- At 1:00 it's time to awaken and start more sessions in the play-yard, after which the dogs hang-out and play or rest quietly.
- Around 7pm happy, tired dogs return home for a peaceful evening, or if boarding, dinner is served followed by a final play time before bed.

\*Outdoors if the weather is nice or our indoor runs which are heated to keep our furry friends comfortable in all climates.
